A Special Place for Children

If your child has a physical, emotional or developmental disability that precludes him/her from enjoying the typical camping experience, Camp STAR invites them to our weeklong program this August. Our staff is composed of skilled counselors who are trained to work with children who have physical, intellectual, emotional and other disabilities. Several experienced counselors are available to the campers around the clock and sleep in the living area of the cabin. The Camp STAR staff employs a number of on-site professionals, including the Camp Director, Assistant Camp Director, head counselors, water safety instructors, group leaders, a registered nurse, and a physician on-call. Medications are professionally administered according to each child's prescription(s). You can rest assured that your child will be safe, well cared for, and have a great camping experience at Camp STAR.

Camp STAR kids enjoy a variety of activities, including field trips, group athletics, swimming, cooking, crafts and nature study. The program is carefully designed to provide campers with a memorable experience. Campers will enjoy group- sleeping accommodations with four or fewer roommates. Sixty campers are served with approximately one staff person for every three children.

The camp also makes frequent use of a large recreation building for crafts and other large indoor group assemblies. Campers and staff swim in Watson Homestead's Olympic sized pool, with lifeguards always on duty. Meals are served in the Watson Homestead dining facility. Special dietary needs are always accommodated.



Camp STAR, founded in 1963, is sponsored by nine Rotary clubs in the Southern Tier of New York State; who are dedicated to the Rotary motto "Service Above Self". There is NO CHARGE for families to have their child attend Camp STAR, and Camp STAR is a 501(c)(3) organization.

Camp STAR is located in the scenic and rural setting of the Watson Homestead Retreat Center in Painted Post, NY. Families are responsible for transporting campers to and from Camp STAR during designated times. Camp STAR recommends that family members do not visit campers during their stay.

Completed applications are due by **July 14**, **2023**.

They are reviewed by the Selection Committee and considered on a first come, first served basis.
